

# EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES

## PLANNING FOR PACT

### What employment opportunities are available through PACT?

PACT requires economic opportunities generated by the conversion to be directed to public housing residents through a federal program called Section 3. Development partners will provide residents with long-term employment prospects, job training, and opportunities for resident-owned businesses. Through the Section 3 program, residents will have access to the following job opportunities:

#### CONSTRUCTION

Laborers, carpenters, assistant superintendents, movers, and more

#### MANAGEMENT

Supers, porters, handymen, and office positions

#### CONTRACT

Contract opportunities for resident-owned businesses

## PREPARING FOR SECTION 3

### 1. CONTACT NYCHA REES OFFICE

Contact your REES Zone Coordinator to learn about Section 3 and PACT employment opportunities.

### 2. REGISTER FOR SECTION 3

Register your interest in the Section 3 program's job opportunities with your NYCHA REES office.

### 3. CONFIRM YOUR CERTIFICATIONS

Work with your REES office to make sure you have the appropriate certifications to perform work on a job site.

### 4. GET CONNECTED TO OPPORTUNITIES

Ask about resources available to residents beyond the Section 3 program.



Priority for Section 3 positions will be given to NYCHA residents who reside in the NYCHA development where the conversion is taking place. Don't wait to get your certificates or complete training!

## WHAT IS REES?

NYCHA's Office of Resident Economic & Employment Sustainability (REES) is a resource available to you as a NYCHA resident. While additional job opportunities with development partners will be available after the PACT conversion, REES will help you connect to resources and prepare for hiring NOW!

## WHAT DOES REES DO?

REES supports residents to increase their income and assets through programs, policies, and partnerships. Through a service coordination 'Zone Model', REES connects working age (18-65) residents through formal partnerships with 70+ economic opportunity providers within 15 zones City-wide, each with a dedicated REES Zone Coordinator. You can use the REES office to:

- Connect to economic opportunities close to home, like hiring events or job trainings
- Learn about Section 3 and other job opportunities
- Enroll in adult education programs
- Take advantage of various NYCHA rent incentive programs
- Improve credit or address debt through financial empowerment services
- Learn how to start or grow a business
